On December 8, 2010 all 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> grade students will be taking the Explore and PLAN tests respectively. These tests are preliminary ACT tests.

The ACT is a test that most students take in the spring of their junior year or the fall of their senior year as part of their college application process.

The tests are being paid for by the school district and students will take the test in our building on the morning of **Wednesday, December 8<sup>th</sup>**. A brochure explaining the test is being given to your student on Monday, November 29<sup>th</sup>. Please review the brochure and call me with any questions you have.
